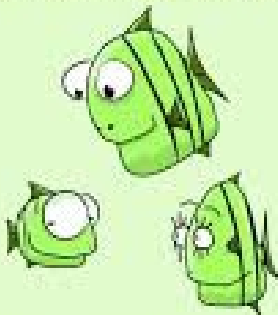

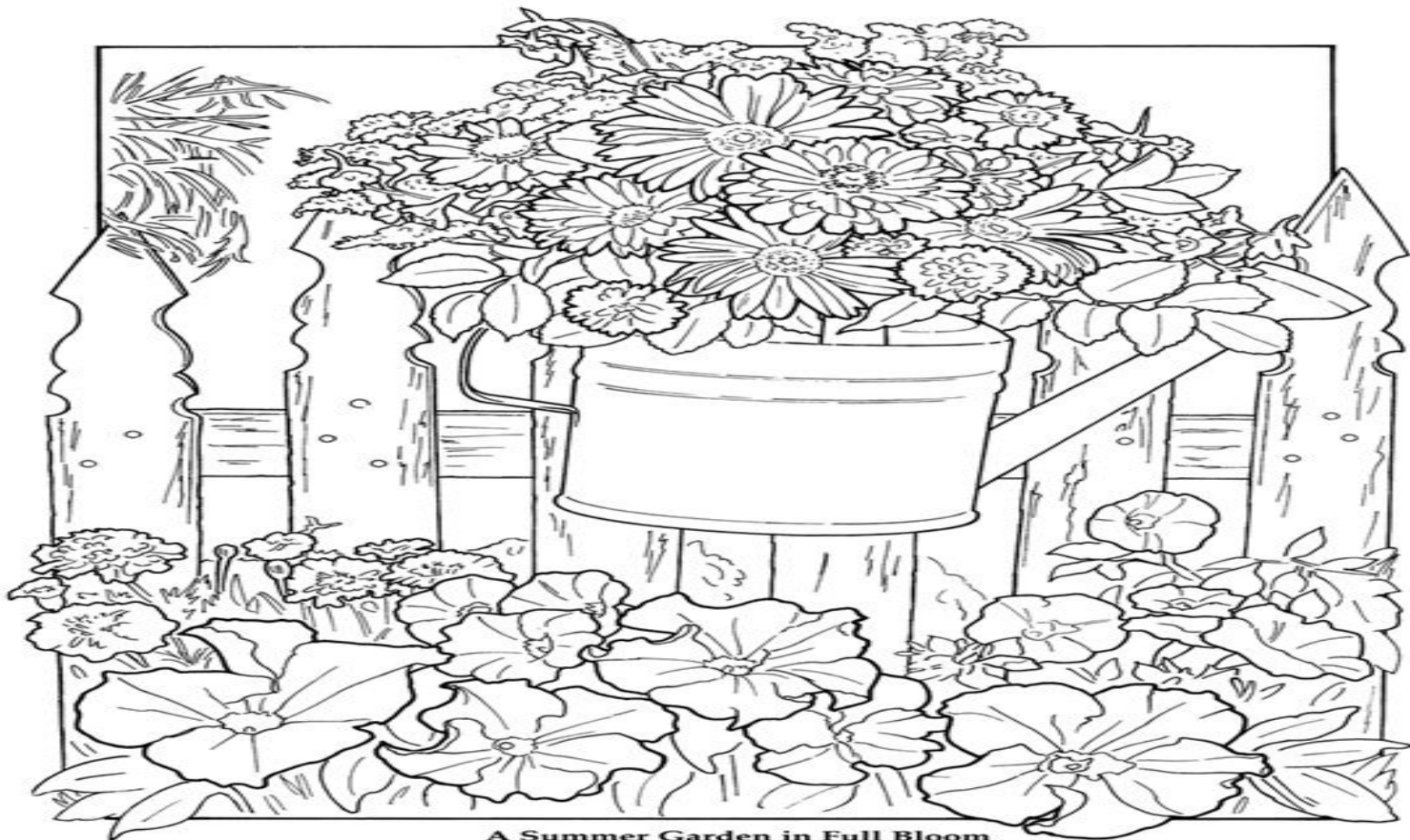

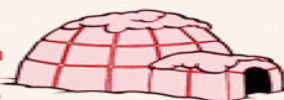


Canada is one of the **Most Scholarly** countries in the world

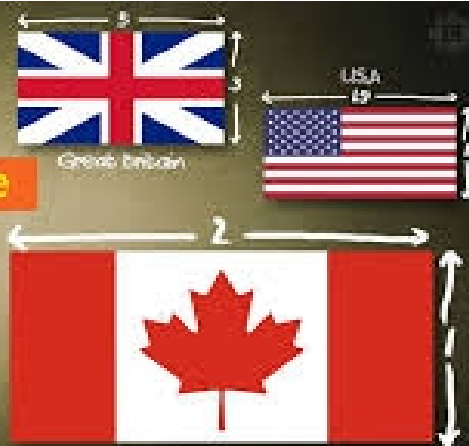

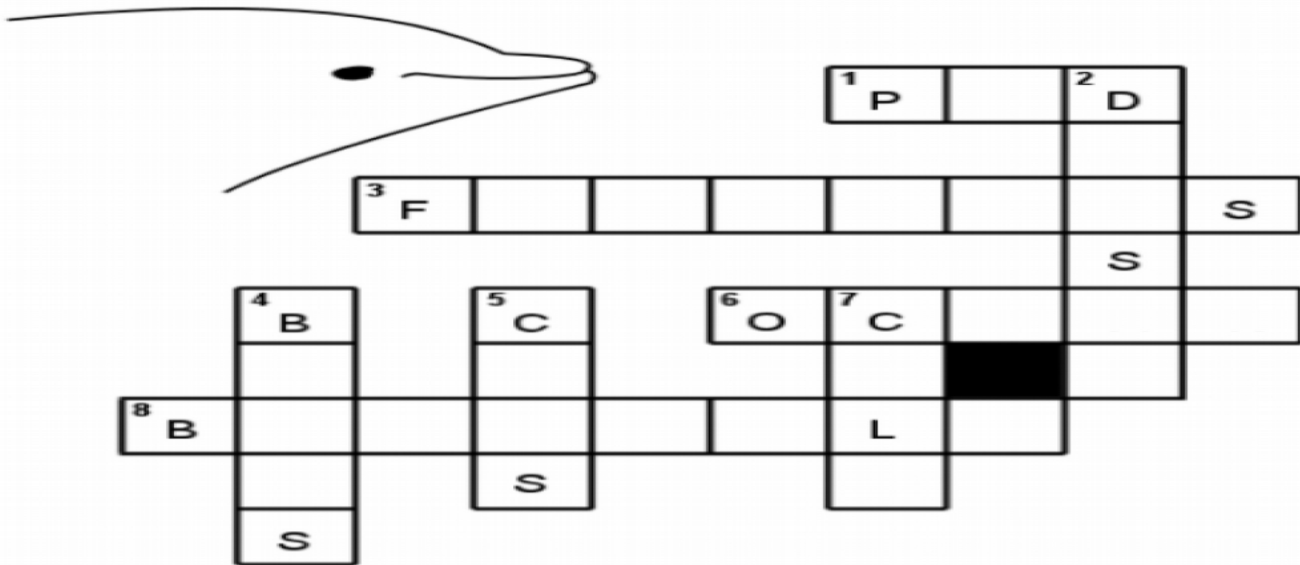
